The GVPS library is taking advantage of this by using it to encourage as many students as possible to take on the Premier’s Reading Challenge this year. Students from 3-6 will be rewarded a book mark for each 5 books read. For 5 books they will receive a bronze bookmark, for 10 they will earn a silver, 15 a gold and for 20 a platinum. Some students have already completed the challenge and have been awarded their set of book marks. Students have plenty of time to read as the challenge does not finish until the end of August.
