We placed students into **new classes** for the year last week. As is always the case at the start of the year there is some degree of uncertainty as to whether this will be the final structure for the year. I am pleased to be able to report that we will not be needing to change from our plans. We have the correct number of students for 16 classes which means we are able to get the year off to a flying start with the students.

One of the things this will mean is that next week, on Wednesday 15th February, we will be able to hold our Meet the Teacher afternoon. SRE classes run every Wednesday. Please contact the office if you need to update your child's Special Religious Education information. Students are expected to attend the religious instruction for which you have given consent and can not change without your written approval.

OFFICE PAYMENTS

Due to banking arrangements, the school office is unable to take any payments after 12.00pm each day. We accept cash and Eftpos & Back to School Vouchers.

ALLERGIES & MEDICATIONS

Students who have asthma or allergy plans in place at school need to have these updated annually. You will be contacted shortly to arrange a new plan if your child's existing plan is more then 12 months old. We ask parents to keep the office updated with new student medical conditions as they arise.

DISCONTINUING SEESAW

The NSW Department of Education has announced that it has procured Apps to support schools in its daily operations. School and student administration products have been vetted rigorously by the NSW DoE to ensure they meet the department's requirements. Schools selecting from these Apps will be able to select products with confidence that products comply with NSW Government contractual terms and meet the correct levels of cyber and data security.

What does this mean?

The newly approved Apps will incorporate many functions into the one App, including parent portals for communication, excursion payment/parent consent, SMS messaging, attendance and student wellbeing.

Consequently, Green Valley Public School will be decommissioning Seesaw in the next couple of weeks. It is requested that parents/carers download any student portfolios/journals they wish to keep as soon as possible as the licence will not be renewed.

We will soon send home details for parents with instructions of how to access the Sentral portal.

We are hopeful that by having just one means of communication we will provide a much more streamlined approach to our communication.
