### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

**Thank you** to our P&C for the organisation of the **disco** on Friday night. Around 270 students had a wonderful time and behaved brilliantly together. It was certainly a nice way to finish off the week for the students.

Thanks also to the P&C for the organisation of the memorial paver fundraiser. These pavers have now been ordered and once they arrive will be laid in the front garden of the school as a marker of the school's 140th birthday. We will be looking for family members, who have appropriate landscaping skills, to volunteer some time to lay the pavers along the pathway. Look out for this notice soon. In the meantime, contact the office if you think you may be able to help.

In this newsletter, you will find some key information about **Kindergarten Orientation** for our 2024 students. This year we are running 6 sessions of orientation for our pre-schoolers so they can have ample opportunity to engage with the primary school setting and families can get a chance to meet our school staff in preparation for next year.

If you know of families who have a child who is turning 5 before the end of July 2024, please let them know to contact the school as their child is eligible to start school next year. The NSW Department of Education enrolment policy states "Parents may enrol their child in Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if the child turns 5 years of age on or before 31 July in that year. The Education Act 1990 mandates that all children must be in compulsory schooling by 6 years of age."

Other important information in the newsletter this time is a reminder to let us know at the office if you are not intending on **continuing with your children at GVPS in 2024** or you are returning but not at the start of the year.

The reason this is important is so we can include your children in official enrolment statistics for the start of the year. If we don't know whether or not you are returning in 2024 with either an email or other written advice, we may fall short on the number of classes we can set up for the year. Students can still be counted if we have something in writing from you that states they will be back to GVPS in 2024 before the end of term 1.

I hope to see you over the course of the week ahead either during the afternoon pick up or at the Book Fair that arrives this week. All the best for the next couple of weeks.


