Grey pants, green & yellow long sleeved polo shirt. Green sloppy-joe or jacket. Black shoes and grey socks. School hat.


Girls Winter:

Our current competition leaders are Suri, Rania, Alexa, Aarnav and Jayden.


Borrowing: Well done to all the students who borrow each library lesson.
