PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Welcome back to the new school year. I am sure you are in for a great year ahead with your child here at Green Valley PS. I encourage you to be as involved in our great school as much as you can throughout the year. Being interested and engaged in your child's education is a great start to ensuring the best results for your child. One way you can get involved is by being part of the school P&C. The second meeting for the year will be **19th March 2025** The meeting starts at 9.00am and takes place in the Cubby House. All families are welcome to attend.

This year we have 15 classes and our numbers have been submitted. Our 2 Kindergarten classes are well settled and the tears have nearly disappeared. A big thankyou to the Kindergarten parents who have supported our school with drop and go in the mornings. This has led to a smoother transition into learning in the mornings.

On a safety note, can I please ask all parents always adhere to the rules out the front of the school. This includes using the school crossing. The traffic is very busy after the bell each day and we want all students to go home safely. We are again asking for greater cooperation regarding the kiss and drop zone in front of the school. This area is strictly reserved for 2-minute stops, and you must not be greater than 3 metres from your car. When all parents/carers comply with these rules, we have observed that traffic flows efficiently. If cars stay in the kiss and drop zone for longer than the legal time, this causes a huge build-up of traffic. We are asking parents/carers to utilise the round-a-bouts that bookend the school, arrange an alternative meeting place, or simply park and walk.

ATTENDANCE

Ordering your lunch

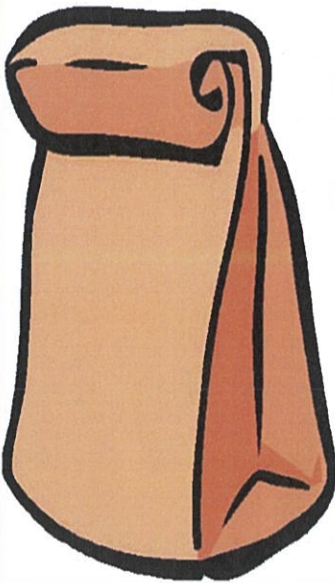
Two simple ways to order your lunch:
