Welcome back to the new school year. I am sure you are in for a great year ahead with your child here at Green Valley PS.

This area is strictly reserved for 2-minute stops, and you must not be greater than 3 metres from your car. When all parents/carers comply with these rules, we have observed that traffic flows efficiently. If cars stay in the kiss and drop zone for longer than the legal time, this causes a huge build-up of traffic. We are asking parents/carers to utilise the round-a-bouts that bookend the school, arrange an alternative meeting place, or simply park and walk.

SRE classes run every Wednesday. Please contact the office if you need to update your child's Special Religious Education information.


### **ALLERGIES & MEDICATIONS**


