ATTENDANCE

Students who arrive late to school (ie miss morning lines) need to first go to the school office for a late note. Please ensure your children arrive in time to make morning lines at 8.50am. If students are absent from school a text message will be sent home asking for an explanation as to the absence. A response to the text is recorded and therefore a note upon return from leave is not required.

SCHOOL HOURS

Students need to be at assembly lines each morning at 8.52am. School finish time is 2.55pm. Please note: students must not use the driveway as an entrance point. Please use the pedestrian gates only.

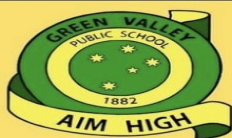

Ordering your lunch

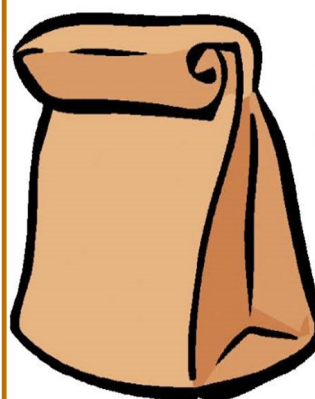
Two simple ways to order your lunch:

ANZAC Day is a time to remember and honour the contributions and sacrifices of Australian and New Zealand Soldiers in all wars and conflicts.



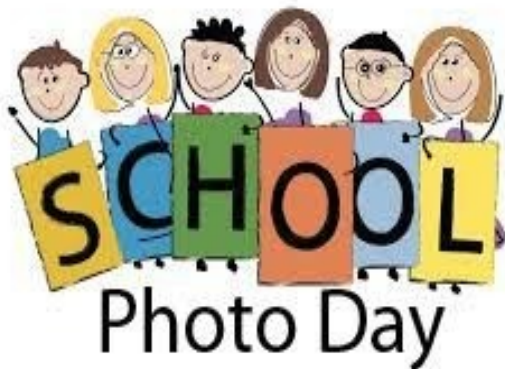
Fancy Hat Parade—11th of April

6th of May - “Muffins with Mum” Mother’s Day Breakfast

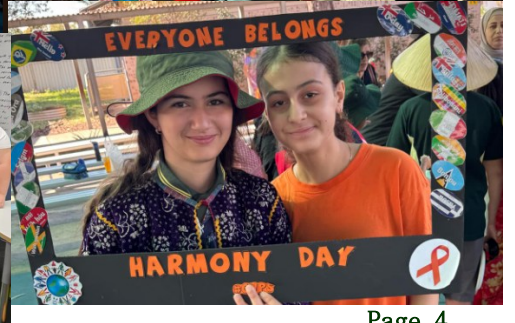
